

EASTER EGG HUNT 2026 (Park Hopping)

- Start by standing on the steps at the Phase 1 Amenity Center by the pool looking out towards the parking lot, follow along to the left towards the main road, Oakleaf Village Parkway.
- When you reach the roadway, turn left onto the sidewalk that goes in front of the pond.
- Turn left on the sidewalk that goes around the pond and is part of the amenity center.
- Stay on the sidewalk and go down by the second/middle bridge and turn right into the neighborhood (Silverleaf) culdesac and follow the sidewalk around to **SILVERLEAF PARK**.
HINT (search all parks on the hunt for eggs)
- Continue on the sidewalk along Silver Bluff and cross the street over to Pebble Sand Lane sidewalk.
- Cross street onto sidewalk that takes you back to the amenity center walking track.
- Cross over the bridge (second/middle bridge) to the track and turn right towards the third bridge by the **SOCCER FIELD PARK**.
- Continue around track to the **FIELD HOUSE PARK**.
- Take the sidewalk between the park and the pool, then follow the sidewalk around by basketball courts.
- Follow the sidewalk in front of the Fitness Center towards the road and turn right onto the sidewalk along Oakleaf Village Parkway to the red light.
- Cross the street at the red light in the crosswalk and turn right on to the sidewalk towards Oakside Drive.
- Turn left onto Oakside Drive (pond side) sidewalk.
- Follow the sidewalk down to **WAVERLY PARK**.
- Continue along the sidewalk on Wakemont Drive until the sidewalk crosses the road.
- Once crossing, continue right onto the sidewalk.
- Cross road to **WAKEMONT PARK**.
- Cross back over to the sidewalk, crossing to the right sidewalk along Laurel Wood.
- Continue on the sidewalk until you get to **WORTHINGTON OAKS PARK**.
- Continue on the sidewalk on Park View towards Oakleaf Village Parkway.
- Cross in front of the entrance sign to the other sidewalk that leads to the **SITTING PARK**.
- Go back out to the sidewalk and cross Oakleaf Village Parkway back to the amenity center.

Please be careful when crossing streets and look out for uneven sidewalks.

Each "PARK" will have at least 1 egg, look for eggs in trees along main roadways and around the amenity center. There will not be any eggs in trees that are part of residents' yards.

COURSE DISTANCE - APPROX 3.5 MILES

REMEMBER TO "FIND" AN EGG YOU MUST TAKE A PIC WITH YOUR PHONE OF YOU WITH THE EGG IN THE TREE BEHIND YOU. PRIZES ARE GIVEN FOR FIRST TO COMPLETE (FINDING ALL 20 EGGS AND THE BUNNY), THE MOST PEOPLE IN YOUR PIC, AND FOR BEING THE MOST CREATIVE (e.g. DRESSING FESTIVE FOR YOUR EGG HUNT)
